

What is college, and how do I get in?

So each applicant can independently make a choice and personally determine which future profession is closer to him in spirit and perception.

And now about the benefits. As a rule, many colleges have agreements with universities that their graduates can enter universities on favorable terms, and immediately in the third year.

For example, very often a college's final exam becomes the entrance exam to a university, and this is very advantageous. According to statistics, most students - state-funded students in universities appear just after college, which means that the graduates have a much better chance to receive a free education at a higher education institution.

Branches of higher education institutions are almost 100% enrollment!

That is why many parents prefer to take their child out of school mostly after ninth grade, so that he can as early as possible begin an in-depth study of his future profession. Even if things don't work out with admission to college, a specialized secondary education also makes it possible to find a decent job with a decent salary upon graduation.
